POSITION OVERVIEW:

The Technical Services Associate provides technical and proposal-writing support to the Client & Technical Services (CTS) division. Additionally, the position will also assist with development and delivery of training materials and production and management of site-facing materials in support of the clinical trials business. Documentation, book-keeping and maintenance of MMI's Customer Relationship Management (CRM) portal will constitute ancillary job-functions. The Tech. Services Associate will liaise with staff from CTS, Business Development, Operations and other consultants to produce comprehensive, technically sound work products.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist CTS staff with scientific and technical consulting activities
- Assist CTS staff with developing business proposals, contract exhibits and letters of agreement
- Conduct periodic reviews of agreements and contracts and initiate amendments as needed
- Manage, develop, and revise training material and assist with its delivery
- Document training activity and results of effectiveness testing
- Develop site-, sponsor- and consultant-facing binders and other project materials (such as guidance for site coordinators, imaging technologists, physician consultants, etc.)
- Assist with preparations for investigator/coordinator meetings, tradeshows, workshops, etc.
- Assist with developing project-specific training materials for technical project staff, including project managers, analysts and physician consultants (i.e., radiologists and cardiologists)
- Support ongoing internal initiatives, including development of training/certification programs for physician reviewers, process improvements, and auditing and consolidating project documents.
- Reinforce client relationships through high-quality work products, responsiveness and timeliness
- Understand Medical Metrics Quality Policy and support the achievement of the organization's quality objectives and take corrective action when necessary to mitigate organizational risk
- Comply with company policies and procedures, as well as ISO 9001 and Current Good Clinical Practices (cGCP's) relative to job tasks
- Assist with maintenance of MMI's CRM platform, including the book-keeping, reports, querysupport, and organization and QC of data and analytics; Staying current on CRM updates
- Aid in developing standardized business processes for proposal development and delivery and consulting activity
- Support internal initiatives aimed at quality improvement, suggest and implement relevant process improvements
